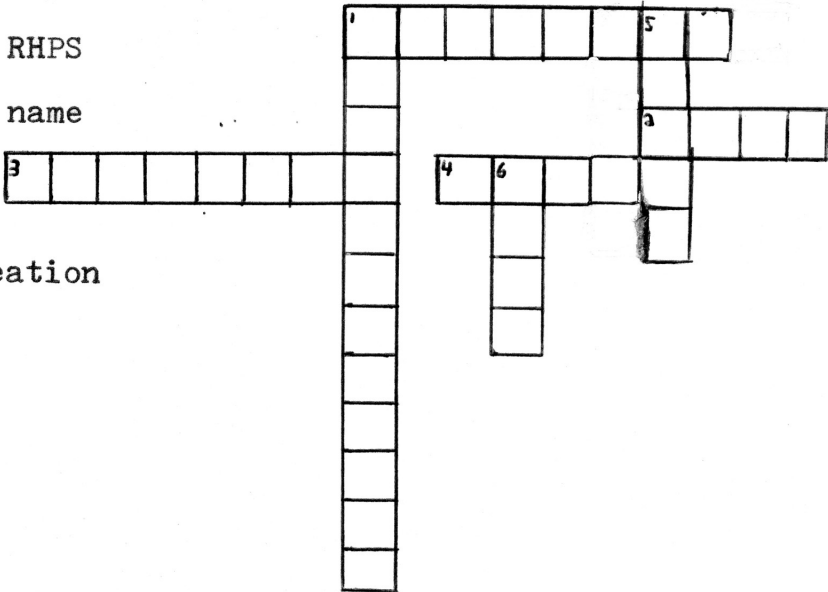
RAY'S CROSSWORD PUZZLE by Ray Prew
