So, if you are interested, please let us know. We are also in need of help in other parts, so let us know about that too. RR

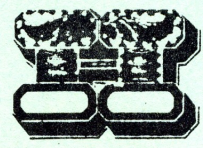
### WE WERE PUZZLED, TOO

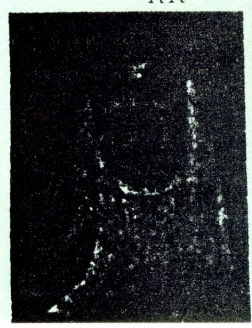


Look's like Gallery knew what they were talking about 10 years ago this month. On the other hand, some places like to prop up a movie just because of limited success.
