Cur last list of changes from the original script:

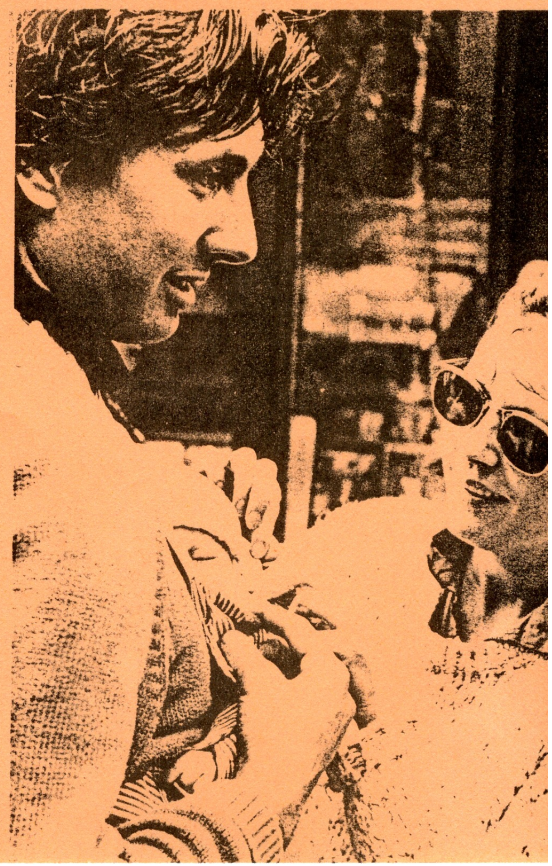
Brad and Janet discovered they were in bed with Frank by turning on a light. For example:

 During "Once in a While" we see several shots of Janet saying these lines:
 What's happening here? Where's Brad?
 Where's anybody?
 I'm engaged to Brad just the same as Betty Monroe was to Ralph Hapschatt. But Frank's kisses overwhelmed me with an ecstasy I've never dreamt of before. Hot, burning kisses.
 I could see Brad's face before me and my mind screamed No! But my lips were hungry - too hungry.
 I wanted to be loved completely. My body throbbed excitedly. Oh Brad my darling, how could I have done this to you? (etc.)
 After Janet says, "If only we hadn't made this journey! (etc.)", the criminologist has the following speech:
