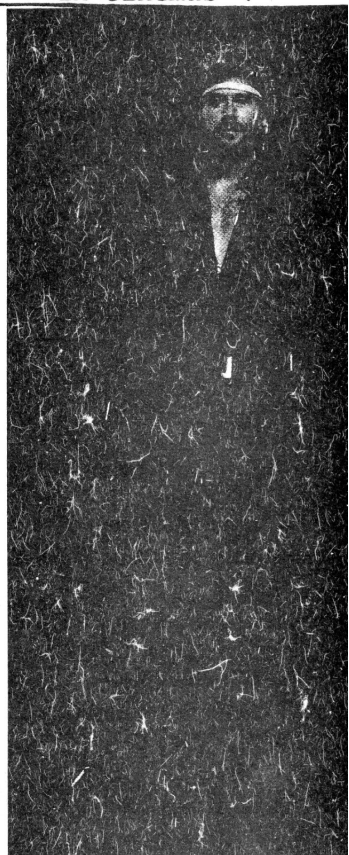

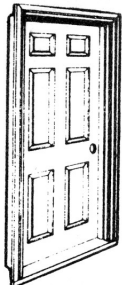
What ever happened to Saturday night,
