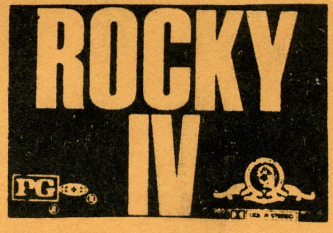

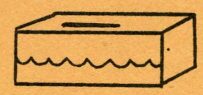
A lot of people are getting fooled. Don't you be one of them. And tell everyone you know the difference.

Things to know at CTC



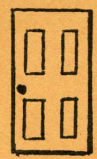
SUGGESTION BOX
