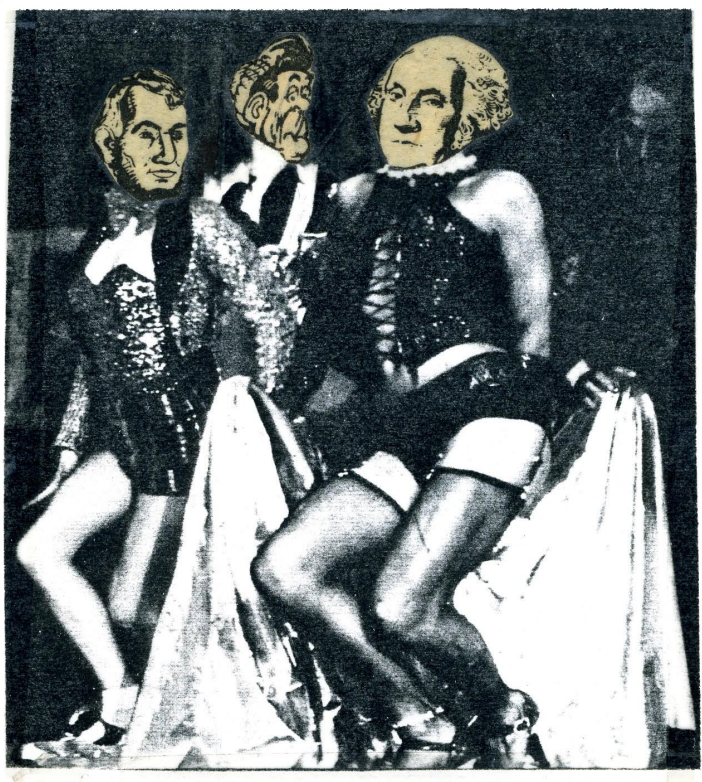
WORDS to the MUSIC
