The Boston cast from the Harvard Square Theatre in Cambridge, MA is keeping us in suspense as to when they'll visit us at the CTC.

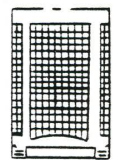
Double Cast Night - What's better than a live cast to play along with your favorite cult movie? Two live casts!

Gender Switch - Basically, boys will be girls and girls will be boys.

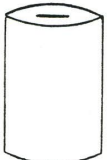
Dress Casual Night - Don't let the name fool you. "Dress casual" means anything goes (almost).
