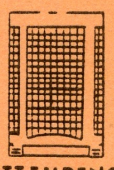

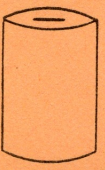
RIR#1 one year ago

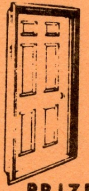
