



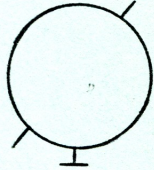

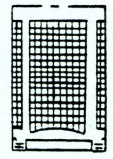
Changes

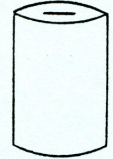

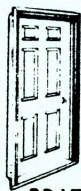
