the aisles or lip-synching dialogue beneath the screen, the audience is heckling the on-screen actors mercilessly.

Everytime the overweight narrator appears, for example, people in the seats start screaming "Where's your neck?" At every mention of the name of the heroine, Janet Weiss, the audience hisses, "Weisssssssss." And at key places in the movie, theater-goers scream out questions that transform innocuous snippets of dialogue into ob-scene jokes.

If that weren't enough, theater patrons throw rice during a wedding scene, shoot water pistols into the air when there's a rainstorm, and toss rolls of toilet paper when one of the actors cries "Great Scott!"

So now, the motion picture that has destroyed countless movie theaters is now available to make a shambles of your living room.

There is, I'm afraid, no narrator

to yell at and very little dialogue to distort. But as computer games go, *Rocky Horror* is very good.

Produced by Electric Dreams, an Activision subsidiary that specializes in bringing good foreign software to the U.S. market, *Rocky Horror* is fun and easy to play.

After deciding whether you will be Brad Majors, the all-American boy, or Ms. Weiss, you have to wander through the mansion of the evil Dr. Frank N. Furter looking for keys to get through locked doors and getting pieces of the DeMedusa machine. You need the device to save your spouse, who has been turned to stone by Frank's Medusa machine.

In the meantime, you have to avoid bumping into the likes of Magenta, the housekeeper with the Bride-of-Frankenstein hairdo; Eddie, who cruises the mansion on his motorcycle; and Riff-Raff, the butler who wanders around with a laser gun that can kill you instantly.

If they or the other characters bump into you, they steal your clothes. You have to wander the mansion, your hands covering unmentionable body parts and find your duds before you can continue rebuilding the DeMedusa machine.

My only complaint about the game is each time you die, you have to wait for the long list of credits to crawl across the screen before you can try again.

But if you invite anyone over to play the game, ask them to leave the rice, water pistols and toilet paper at home.

*The Rocky Horror Show* is available on Commodore (\$29.95) and Apple (\$34.95) computer systems.

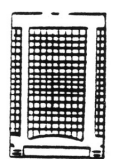
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### PENN CAST
