

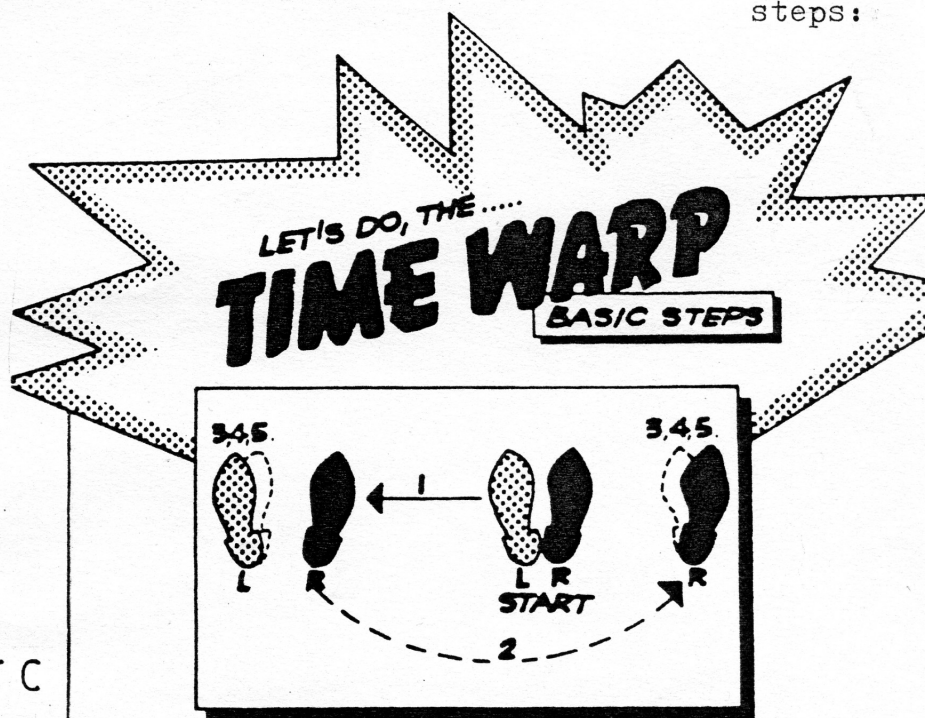
Interview with FRANK n FURTER

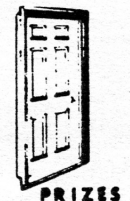
