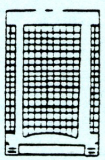
It's been called the next great cult movie. Of course, we all know the current great cult movie. It's been around 12 years. It may go on much longer. So, if LITTLE SHOP OF HORRORS is to take it's place, it may find the "old" champion difficult to unseat.

The simularities beyond the names are striking. LITTLE SHOP, like ROCKY, is a movie derived from a play. The play LITTLE SHOP OF HORRORS originally, however came from a low-budget movie made in 1960 in 2 days staring Jack Nicholson in his first movie. It was the type of low-budget sci-fi horror flicks of the 50's and early 60's that inspired Richard O'Brien to write the ROCKY HORROR SHOW play.

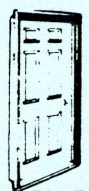
There are some simularities among the characters. The most obvious one is between the "Nerd" of LITTLE SHOP and "Brad" of ROCKY. The man-eating plant rivals Dr. Frank N. Furter in single-minded desire, the former for meat, human meat, and the later for sex. Both movies also feature short but strong appearances from demented motorcycle riders, the "Dentist" and "Eddy." Both also contain spoken dialouge and songs.

LITTLE SHOP, like ROCKY, once did, has gone through it's first running. It had moderate success, whereas ROCKY bombed. Now it's up to the theatres. Rocky was brought back for a second running and became the greatest cult movie of all time. Will LITTLE SHOP do the same? Or will it become, as some claim it to be, the "other" feature the Lips sing about in "Science Fiction Double Feature?"
