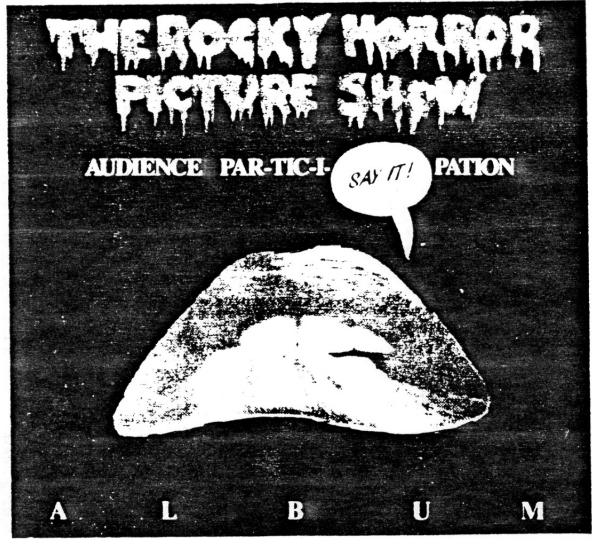

The Rocky Horror Picture Show audience participation Album has finally been released and it was worth waiting for. To celebrate the album's completion, fan club president Sal Piro hosted a special Halloween screening of the movie at the Los Angeles Roxy theater. The Roxy was the home of the original "Rocky Horror Show" in America.

The album was recorded live during a midnight show at the 8th Street Playhouse in New York. The special two-record set not only features all of the songs and dialogue, but also contains fully orchestrated line shouting. Sal adds spice to the album with his famous in-theater warm-up, an official Rocky Horror prop list, rules of etiquette, plus a detailed libretto of audience responses.

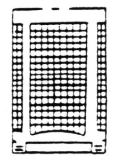
