

AUD: BUY AN UMBRELLA. CHEEP—ITCH
CUE: (chorus) There's a Light.
AUD: Light flashlights, but not aiming directly at screen. Please don't use matches or lighters CUE: (B) is Brad Majors. AUD: A—HOLE

CUE: RIFF RAFF (RR) You're wet. AUD: NO. S—T. RIFF

AUD: TELL HIM HOW KIND HE IS, JANET

CUE: ...come inside.
