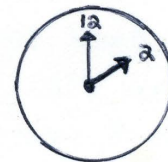

Hi. Have you ever left the show saying to yourself or the next person "I don't want to go home just yet". Or, "I'm hungry". Well, this columns for you. Surprizingly, there are many resturants open at that hour if you don't mind driving ... a while.

Let's start with my favorite, Wes's Rib House in Onlyville. Here you will find a good selection of barbique food that is actually cooked over a real wood fire. Unfortunately, there are little or no veggies. In fact, I can safely say that this is the only resturant that doesn't have french fries. Plenty of meats, though, but a little expensive. They're open until about 3 or 4 in the mourning.

Howard Johnson's. We all know that they are open 24 hours a day. Some may have different names now, however, as some from the chain were sold recently. Now heres a resturant if you have a group as large as the cast. You might have to wait a while, but otherwise you can get seated quickly. They have a wide selection of foods, most anything you want moderately priced. In fact, the different HoJo's in Pawtucket, Providence, Warwick, and Seekonk have been a favorite of the cast's for years.

Bickford's is another good one. As always, it is difficult to seat large numbers, but the selection is good and service is usually prompt.

The Haven Brothers in downtown Providence. What can I say at 2 in the morning if bikers and prostitutes and winos are your kind of crowd. Enjoy. Being a trailer parked next to the City Hall's steps, they have unlimited seating. However, you stand in line to get your meal. The prices are good, though.

The Fountain Royale in Onlyville. This place is definately for a select crowd. I personally ate there only once, but I understand the food is good and the service is good.

McManus and son. This is an old favorite of the cast (from our 2 1/3 years at Cumberland Twin Cinemas) on Mineral Spring Ave in North Providence. They have a good selection moderately priced. This place also has the rudest hostess in the world. Last week, we tried the McManus in Warwick and found it far different.
