ROSSI SAYS "IT WAS THE BALLS"

Once again the boys from Boston put together a spectacular pre-show, this time touching upon a western theme. Reliable sources have quoted cast director Roy Rossi as saying "It was the balls."

The show opened with a mock gunfight, leading straight into the "Rodeo Song", performed by Jay Brooks. The catchy beat of the song, as well as the lyrics won the audience over in a hurry. Following "Rodeo Song" came a Blues Brothers variation of "Rawhide". Poor coordination on the parts of performers Chip Chipman and Mike Kobar, however, as well as lack of audience participation made "Rawhide" the first flop in modern pre-show history.

Third, and probably most well performed song of the evening was "Devil Went Down to Georgia". The country smash featured the sexy SheilaRae Carpentier as the sultry devil, and Matt Donga in his first major pre-show role as Johnny. The song also featured a cameo appearance by Chip and Jay as the "demons".

The show was wrapped up with "Thank God I'm a Country Boy", Performed by Chip and Jay. Much to the surprise of the cast, the song was a hit with the audience who responded with claps, yahoos, applause, and shouts from the ladies "take it off". All in all the pre-show was again an astounding success.
