After a couple weeks of grabbing fans, that had been slightly interested, we had put together a fairly good cast. These were the first steps into the dark unknown of cast coordination.

At first we performed in make-shift costumes in the dark or with a flashlight. Slowly but surely we up-graded our attire, aided by a professional costume designer. I was able to get ahead of a friend, who is extremely talented with his hands, that built us a follow spot light complete with color filters and dimmer. He also built props, needed for the show.

Our official opening, last September, was a sell-out. With a little advertising help from the theater, our show was a wonderful success. That's not bad considering the theater would've been only half full, before we started performing there. Since then, we have had a special show for each major holiday, selling out each time. Attendance has improved greatly since we perform on normal weekends, virtually filling the house.

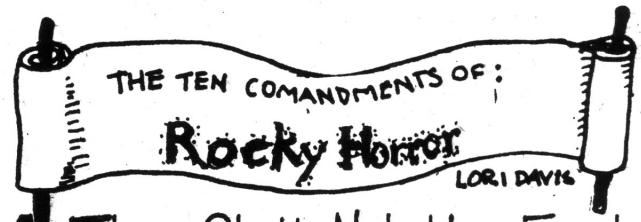
