It ran from 1978 to 1982 in one theatre, the Cinerama, in Providence (please tell me you have heard of Providence). also ran from (I think) 1979 to 1982 at the Jane Pickens in Newport (thats hopefully the other city you've heard of from RI, you know, the one with mansions, Claus Von Bulow, and all that).
